



2023 Tuition and Payment Policy

Trident Gymnastics runs on a monthly direct debit payment system. Our secure payment gateway debits your nominated card each month, for that month in advance. When classes aren't running (e.g., public holidays) your fees are adjusted for that month.

An annual insurance and registration fee is charged when you initially sign up and is paid once per calendar year.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

Tuition Fees

- Fees are debited in advance on the first banking day of the month;
- Fees are charged according to the number of hours the gymnast is enrolled and the number of classes falling in the calendar month;
- As fees are paid in advance, gymnasts may be charged for missed classes, which can be rescheduled in an equivalent class subject to availability.
- Debit memberships are ongoing and we require written notice a minimum of 15 days prior to the end of the month to cease. No refund or credit will be applied if you choose not to attend any paid classes.



Payment Methods

- All payments are made through our online Customer Portal
- No other payment methods are accepted

Declined Payments

- Any declined transactions will incur an administration fee of \$15.00 per transaction

Registration and Insurance

- We charge a compulsory annual insurance and registration fee when you initially sign up and ongoing each calendar year. The registration payment covers vital gymnast insurance and membership of Trident Gymnastics Club Pty Ltd, Gymnastics Victoria and Gymnastics Australia.
- The price of registration remains the same during Terms 1-3. During Term 4 the registration fee decreases.

Competitions

- An additional fee is charged for entry to competitions, carnivals, tours, events or clinics;
- To be eligible, gymnasts must be fully paid-up members at the time of nomination and participation.



CLASSES

- Classes run during Victorian School Terms as gazetted by the Victorian Government.
- Trident may replace a gymnast's regular class with a clinic/carnival/competition/event session.
- Trident reserves the right to cancel classes, and make up tokens will be issued;
- A position in a class will only be held for the period a gymnast has a valid paid-up membership.
- Classes do not operate on Public Holidays as gazetted by the Victorian Government

Missed Classes and Makeup Tokens

It is normal that gymnasts will be unable to attend their scheduled class due to other commitments or illness. Whilst we will make every effort to reschedule missed classes, they are not a right of membership.

- All absences for **future** classes are required to be submitted via the online portal;
- To receive a make-up token, the absence must be submitted a minimum of 1 hour before the class commences. A make-up token will be applied to the gymnast's file and the make-up class reschedule can be booked online using the token;
- Make up tokens will expire **one month** from which the missed class was scheduled;
- Make up classes are forfeited after withdrawal, apart from tokens that were issued because the club cancelled classes;
- You must be actively enrolled in classes to use make up tokens.
- Makeup tokens cannot be used in holiday program sessions

Dangerous weather/shutdown conditions

- The Club will follow advice from State Emergency Services and government regarding severe weather warnings and shut down due to pandemic or health concerns.
- Refunds or make up lessons will be provided as a right if dangerous weather or health advice require the cancellation of classes.

Refunds

- We do not issue credits or refunds for missed classes except in exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of management;
- Under no circumstances will any costs associated with membership be refunded.
